### **BEAT THE RUSH AND GRAB A BARGAIN, URGES LUXURY SELF-CATERING CELTIC HAVEN**

Set within the outstanding scenery of the Pembrokeshire National Park, Celtic Haven is a village resort of 26 cottages and houses, overlooking the Atlantic and the monastic island of Caldey, famed for its lavender-based products.

With comprehensive facilities including West Wales' only Elemis Premier Spa, sauna, gym, indoor swimming pool, all-weather tennis courts and a nine-hole headland golf course, Celtic Haven is offering savings on accommodation for families and couples able to get away before the summer school holidays.

Between June 5 and July 3, Celtic Haven has three-bedroom cottages sleeping six at £125 per person per week, based on full occupancy. In peak season, the price is £229 per person, giving a saving of 45 per cent. Four people staying in a two-bedroom cottage would each pay £162 a week, instead of £248 in July or August, offering a 35 per cent reduction.

The Pembrokeshire National Park is renowned for its coastal walks, beaches and scenic inland countryside. Parts of the Celtic Haven resort date back 800 years as the site was once the estate of Lord St David and the resort is ideal for children and also allows guests to bring their dogs.

Guests seeking a traditional cottage experience can stay in one of the 16 12<sup>th</sup> century buildings in the original part of Celtic Haven. From *The Parlour*, a cosy romantic cottage for two, to the *Manor House*, sleeping 12 in six bedrooms, each property has been tastefully converted and retains original beamed ceilings.

Alternatively, those looking for a more modern approach, Celtic Haven includes a more recent raised courtyard of 10 properties with breathtaking views over Lydstep Bay and Caldey Island.

All properties are equipped to luxury standard with full kitchens, including dishwasher and washing machine, CD stereo, TV, video/DVD player and central heating.

And for those wanting a break from self-catering the resort has its own popular Waves Italian restaurant and bar.
