Celtic Haven: The perfect recipe for Christmas breaks

London, 15 November 2010:

Cook up a classic Christmas – cosy cottage, hot-tub and tasty treats – amidst some of Britain’s best scenery with Celtic Haven, which has a limited number of four-night packages remaining over the festive season.

Celtic Haven, a resort of 26 cottages, set within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park, has some Christmas availability remaining and is offering cottages from December 21 to 27 starting from £35 per person per night for a four-night break.

Celtic Haven is close to Tenby in west Wales and is on an historic site, being the former estate of Lord St David. It boasts cottages and houses sleeping from two to 12, making them ideal for family get-togethers or cosy romantic locations for couples.

Scenic coastal walks through the national park overlook the Atlantic and the nearby monastic island of Caldey. Free use of all the resort’s leisure facilities, including sauna, gym, indoor swimming pool, all-weather tennis courts and the nine-hole headland golf course, is also included in the cost of the Christmas stays. The resort’s own Italian-themed restaurant Waves is closed on Christmas Day and Boxing day, but open the other days leading up to Christmas.

But guests do not have to worry about shopping for Christmas meals as major supermarket chains will deliver internet grocery orders – including Christmas trees! - to individual cottages before they arrive. So all the Christmas goodies can be bought via the web in advance and Celtic Haven staff will put wine and perishables in the fridge.

On Christmas Eve there is a free *Fireworks with Santa* event for all guests – mince-pies, mulled wine, gifts from Father Christmas and a dazzling fireworks display will provide a sparkling start to a Christmas holiday.
