



Get reeled in to Pembrokeshire Fish Week with Celtic Haven

May 31 2011: Foodies looking for some-fin special this June can stay in Celtic Haven's self catering cottages on the Pembrokeshire coastline and catch the fun at Pembrokeshire Fish Week. Celtic Haven's 26 cottages are a short drive from the award winning annual fish festival, which this year takes place from 25 June- 3 July. Prices start from just £487 for a short break in a four-person cottage.

The luxury cottage resort is a 30-minute drive from Milford Haven where the festival takes place. There will be over 250 events dedicated to celebrating Pembrokeshire's fresh seafood, protected coastline, sandy beaches and maritime heritage such as fishing competitions and cookery events.

Highlights of the festival include 'Cook your Catch' which is a seafood masterclass from five top British chefs including Mark Hix and Mitch Tonks. Those who are looking for something more active can join in the 'Make like a Fish' programme where kids and adults can attempt surfing, coasteering, canoeing, kayaking, sailing or learning to skipper a powerboat. Other excitements at the festival include tastings, fishing lessons and children's workshops.

After a day of fishy fun, visitors can return to Celtic Haven's coastal cottages, many of which have sea views. The cottages are set within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park and sleep from two to 12 people. The sandy Lydstep Beach is just a short walk away and Celtic Haven is connected to miles of headland paths.

A three-night weekend or a four night midweek break during the festival starts from £487 for a two-bedroom cottage sleeping up to four people. A week-long break starts from £650.

Guests have free use of Celtic Haven's private indoor swimming pool, fitness suite, hot tub, sauna, tennis courts and nine-hole golf course. Celtic Haven also has the only Elemis Premier Spa in west Wales with over 80 treatments and 'Waves' restaurant that will feature a special Fish Week menu.
