



Short, mid and long haul late availability trips from The Adventure Company

9 June 2009: Travellers still choosing holidays for this summer should consider one of the options from The Adventure Company. Whether it be a short haul activity break to Turkey, or a chance to explore the Okavango Delta in dugout canoes, there is still a range of far-flung and closer-to-home adventures available.

Short haul

National Bike Week starts in the UK on June 13th. Travellers inspired to hop on their bikes should head to Turkey and try mountain biking in Kas on the Turkey Activity Week.

As well as just biking, Turkey Activity Week's itinerary includes sea kayaking around the sunken city of Kekova, diving in the Med and white water rafting on the Dalaman River – all included in the price. The eight-day trip departs on September 4th and costs £689 per person with an £80 local payment upon arrival.

Mid haul

Travellers looking to conquer a mountain this summer should take on Mount Toubkal on The Adventure Company's Atlas Break. Mount Toubkal is North Africa's highest peak (4,167m) and the summer months offer more favourable conditions for climbing than in winter.

The eight-day Atlas Break includes a guided city walk in the lively Marrakech, acclimatising walks in Imlil, Mount Toubkal summit climb and an over night camp at Neltner Refuge.

The trip departs on August 7th 2009 and costs £579 per person with an £80 local payment upon arrival. The price includes flights, accommodation, transport, guided walks and most meals (seven breakfasts, three lunches and four dinners). Long haul

Those looking for a more relaxed, longer trip should try the Delta to Victoria Falls in Southern Africa. The 17-day trip, which is also now available at a discount, combines wildlife encounters through South Africa, Namibia, Botswana and Zambia.

The itinerary includes trips through the Okavango Delta in traditional dugout canoes; wild camping and game walks designed to get you closer to the wildlife, along with game drives in the wildlife-rich Savuti and Chobe National Park and Moremi Game Reserve. Finally, you'll get the opportunity to see the mighty Victoria Falls from Livingstone, on the Zambian side.

The trip departs on August 21st 2009 and there is now a £200 discount on the advertised brochure price, so the 17-day trip costs £1,899 instead of £2,099 per person. A local payment of US\$300 is also required upon arrival. The price includes flights, accommodation, transport, activities as per the itinerary and most meals (13 breakfasts, 11 lunches and eight dinners).
